The mission of Share Pregnancy and Infant Loss Support, Inc. is to serve those whose lives are touched by the tragic death of a baby through pregnancy loss, stillbirth, or in the first few months of life.

COMFORT KITS AND SIBLING BAGS

Share provides comfort kits to families who have experienced a loss to provide hope and healing during the darkest days. These special boxes are available at burials, support groups and other Share events. The sibling bags are designed to help children cope with the loss of a brother or sister.



OUR COMFORT ROOM

The care that bereaved parents receive following the death of their baby is crucial. These experiences may stay with parents for the rest of their lives, and the environment in which care is provided is especially important. **Share Pregnancy & Infant Loss Support, Inc. is the only organization in the St. Louis area that provides a comfort room for parents grieving the loss of their baby.** The new Share office has become a place and space deliberately carved out for families to freely mourn and show their grief.
